To all whom it may Concern:



Know ye, That Erastus E. Chase a
Private of Captain James H. Stewart
Company, (D.) 91st Regiment of New York Veterans
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the Second day of September
one thousand eight hundred and Sixty four to serve One year or
during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States,
this Seventeenth day of June 1865, at Baltimore
Maryland by reason of G.O. No 53, dated Feb. 2nd 1865, Middle Military Division
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)*

Said Erastus E. Chase was born in New York
in the State of New York, is thirty years of age,
5 feet 11 inches high, fair complexion, Blue eyes,
Brown hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a machinist
Given at Baltimore this Seventeenth (17) day of
June 1865.
